APPLICATION OF ROSE VALLEY WATER COMPANY FOR A LIMITED WAIVER OF A.A.C. R14-2-410.A.2, FOR APPROVAL OF A TARIFF FOR WATER SERVICE TERMINATION AT THE REQUEST OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, FOR APPROVAL OF A TARIFF FOR SHARING CUSTOMER WATER CONSUMPTION INFORMATION WITH THE CITY OF PEORIA, AND FOR RELATED APPROVALS.

Preface

Rose Valley Water Company (“Rose Valley”) desires a backup interconnection for emergency water delivery from the City of Peoria (“Peoria” or the “City”). In order to secure this backup emergency interconnection with Peoria, Rose Valley has been asked by the City to submit this tariff request to the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) to authorize Rose Valley (i) to share information on water usage by Rose Valley customers who are also sewer customers of Peoria; and (ii) to terminate water service to Rose Valley customers who are delinquent on the payment of Peoria sewer charges.

Summary

On March 22, 2019, Rose Valley filed an application (“Application”) with the Commission for approval of the following: (i) an Agreement for Water Service Termination and Sharing of Information Regarding Water Consumption between Rose Valley and the City of Peoria; (ii) a limited waiver of Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-2-410.A.2; (iii) a new Tariff for Water Service Termination at the Request of the City of Peoria (“Water Service Termination Tariff”); (iv) a new Tariff for Sharing Customer Water Consumption Information with the City of Peoria (“Data Sharing Tariff”); and (v) other waivers, approvals and/or authorizations as may be required by the Commission in order to approve the new tariffs. The purpose of the proposed Water Service Termination Tariff (and the requested limited waiver from A.A.C. R14-2-410.A.2) is to assist the City of Peoria in collecting delinquent payments for sewer service provided to common customers of Rose Valley and the City. The City of Peoria provides sewer service to many of the water customers of Rose Valley. The Water Service Termination Tariff will authorize Rose Valley to shut off water service to a Rose Valley customer who is delinquent in his or her payment of a Peoria sewer bill, even if the customer is not delinquent in the payment of a Rose Valley water bill.

The purpose of the Data Sharing Tariff is to allow Rose Valley to share water consumption information for common customers of Rose Valley and Peoria in order to assist the City in billing for sewer service. The City of Peoria would only be authorized to use such water consumption information for the purpose of sewer service billing and would not be allowed to disclose such information to any other person or entity except as may be required by law.

THE COMMISSION IS NOT BOUND BY THE PROPOSALS MADE BY ROSE VALLEY, THE COMMISSION’S UTILITIES DIVISION STAFF, OR INTERVENORS TO THIS MATTER, IF ANY. THE COMMISSION WILL DETERMINE THE APPROPRIATE ACTION TO BE TAKEN IN THIS MATTER BASED ON THE EVIDENCE OF RECORD.
